
Quick Reference Guide for Schools

Please remember - when interacting with people always...



Wash hands frequently (for at least 20 seconds) or use hand sanitizer with a minimum of 60% alcohol



Clean surfaces frequently including door handles, rails, hoists etc.



Avoid touching your face, nose and eyes



PPE is not needed for educational staff in schools

Based on the current knowledge of Covid-19 infection and transmission it appears that children are both unlikely to cause significant spread of the virus and do not usually experience severe illness. For this reason educational settings are currently perceived to be low risk and usual precautions such as handwashing should be sufficient to reduce risk of spread and PPE is not required
