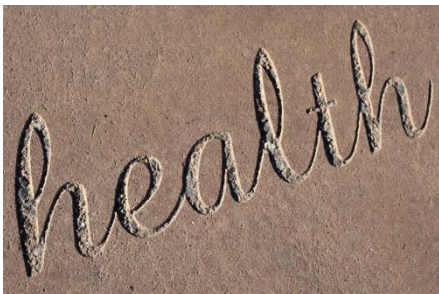


- Based on Enfield/Bromley regional “Outcomes” training, developed and delivered by Fazilla Amide

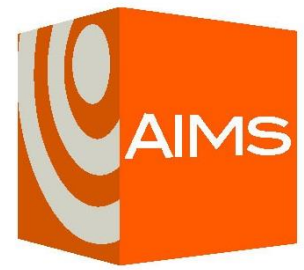
Who Is It Aimed At?

We've included as many ways of learning, to suit all learning styles!

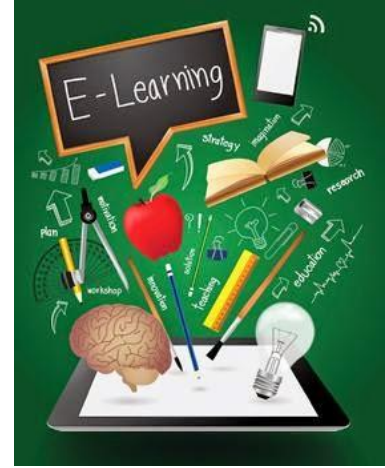


Aims of the Programme

- To explain the key SEND Principles and Duties underpinning Part 3 of the Children and Families Act 2014, within the SEND Code of Practice 0-25, 2015
- Differentiate between Aspirations, Needs, Outcomes, Provision and Targets & how they link
- Develop robust SMART but flexible Outcomes from Aspirations

Structure

- All 5 Modules include short activities
- Can save what you have done at any stage
- Can move around as you wish
- Each module should take between 15- 30 mins
- Final assessment to test/consolidate learning
- Must pass this to complete the SEND E-Learning Foundation Programme



CPD Accreditation

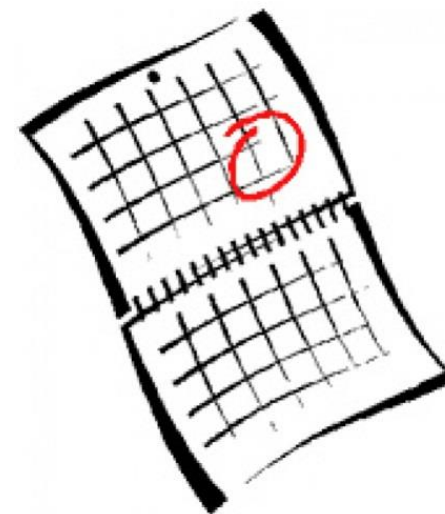


- Learners will receive a record of completion
